INVITATION

The VII International Strawberry Symposium will be held in Beijing, China, from 18th to 22nd February, 2012. The Organizing Committee of the VII ISS is formed by the Chinese Society for Horticultural Science, the People's Government of Beijing Municipality, Beijing Municipal Commission of Rural Affairs, Beijing Municipal Commission of Science and Technology, Beijing Municipal Bureau of Landscape and Forestry, Beijing Municipal Bureau of Agriculture, Beijing Academy of Agricultural and Forestry Sciences, Strawberry Section of Chinese Society for Horticultural Science, the People's Government of Changping District, Beijing, and China International Conference Center for Science and Technology. The International Society for Horticultural Science and the Organizing Committee of VII ISS have the honor and privilege of inviting you to participate in this most important international event concerning the strawberry research and production.

The theme of the symposium is Green, Freshness, Health and Development. The symposium will focus on the exchange of research results and latest advances for industry development in green and environmental-friendly production, in order to promote the sustainable development in strawberry industry within the framework of fresher and healthier life style.

The scientific program includes four days of plenary sessions and panel expositions, as well as invited speeches by renowned guest speakers.
